Further to the ADIPS inspectors meeting held 27th FEBRUARY 2002 Norbreck hotel Blackpool.

Our thanks to Eric Pirie of the HSE for his excellent speech detailing the way forward and the question and answer session that followed.

Our Chief Executive Julien outlined our program for the coming Year.

The fairground JAC have indicated that the ADIPS documentation for main fairground industry is to be updated.

In line with this BACTA is in the process of revising the coin operated kiddie ride documents to conform.

Additionally a sticker system is to be introduced which will help to easily identify rides that have undergone a current inspection.

Eric expressed concern over some newer rides that were on show. Care should be taken that rides inspected within the BACTA scheme fall within our remit. Rides that do not should be subject to the full ADIPS Scheme.

The limitations applying to the BACTA scheme are laid out in the BACTA guidance. However commonsense should always be used and if any anomalies arise that are not clear or developments take place which appear to nullify parts of the guidance, please notify the BACTA office who in turn will seek advice of the Kiddie ride committee, JAC or the HSE.
