TESTING OF OLDER RIDES CLAIMING MATURITY OF DESIGN.

Most rides of british manufacture have demonstrated adequate safety over the years. however there are exceptions, it is essential that even rides from our most diligent manufactures be tested fully.

Although it is not expected that mature rides conform to the **BACTA** code in every respect, it is expected that in the vital safety area's compliance is complete.

As the highest risk with any **Kiddie ride** is generally associated with electricity it is vitally important that this aspect of the ride is given full attention and complies fully with current practice.

Most of the rides that have not reached adequate standards of safety are well known to experienced examiners. However in the process of testing should any faults or hazards become apparent on a ride please report the facts to **BACTA** so that they may be highlighted in future bulletins and form the basis of a data base for the use of all **ADIP'S** examiners.
